Victoria provides employers with a skilled labor force

With a labor pool numbering over 185,000 potential employees within a 55-mile radius, Victoria leverages The Victoria College, Workforce Solutions Golden Crescent, and Texas Vocational Schools to deliver customized training skills to a ready labor force.

- Texas is a Right-to-Work state.
- Low union profile in the manufacturing sector.
- Texas has the nation's second largest work force with over 11 million workers; and boasts the nation's third largest pool of graduate scientists and second largest pool of graduate engineers.
- Texas has instituted major reforms in worker's compensation, lowering employer's costs substantially over the past several years.
- More than \$250M in federal funds available annually in Texas for training services to disadvantaged, unskilled and dislocated workers.
